



Flag of Luxembourg

Adopted on June 23, 1972.

The colours of the flag of Luxembourg were first adopted around 1830 during the Belgian Revolution. They were probably derived from the counts, dukes and later grand-dukes of Luxembourg's coat of arms which in turn was derived from the combination of the dukes of Limbourg's Lion and the supposed striped banner of the early counts of Luxembourg.

The three-colored horizontal design was fixed on June 12, 1845.
