


Celebrating Liichtmessdag in Luxembourg

Make Your Own Lantern

Materials:

Glue and scissors
Coloring Pencils/Crayons
Battery-operated candle

Directions:

- Print 4 of the side of the lantern and one the bottom.
- Color and cut out the sides and bottom.
- With the square bottom piece, glue the "flap" on the edges to one rectangular side.
- Glue the lantern side edges with the extra "flap" to the next lantern side, forming a box with an open top.
- All that's left is to put a batteryoperated candlestick inside and watch it glow!
