




## **Explore the Past**

The discovery box is a collection of touchable artifacts and primary resource materials that allow students of all ages to experience history!

## **Objective**

The objective of the box is to have students recognize, analyze, and connect past events, people, and ideas to the present and contextualize historical events as it relates to the Luxembourg American experience, as well as understand the cause and effect of these events. The box is also great for senior citizens, especially those in memory care, as it helps to spark memories of their personal pasts.





### Activities

Not only does the box have artifacts for you to investigate, but there are activities for multiple levels of engagement. These activities include a coloring activity sheet; photograph identification using historic photos of farm life and stone houses; comparing stone houses in Wisconsin with stone houses in Luxembourg; and building your own stone house using pebbles and PlayDoh.

#### Cost
